In addition, President Vladimir Putin's remarks suggesting Russian use

of nuclear weapons fundamentally trample on the thoughts of the people

of Japan - the only country in the world that has experienced the

devastation of nuclear bombs first-hand - who have been working hard to

abolish nuclear weapons.

This city, which made the "Peaceful City Declaration" in 2006, calls for

the abolition of nuclear weapons, enactment of measures to pursue

permanent peace in the world, and demands an immediate ceasefire and

a peaceful resolution.
